Our God is Faithful

⁷ Then Moses called to Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you shall go with this people into the land which the LORD has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall give it to them as an inheritance." ⁸ "The LORD is the one who goes ahead of you; He will be with you. He will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." ⁹ So Moses wrote this law and gave it to the priests, the sons of Levi who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and to all the elders of Israel. ¹⁰ Then Moses commanded them, saying, "At the end of every seven years, at the time of the year of remission of debts, at the Feast of Booths, ¹¹ when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God at the place, which He will choose, you shall read this law in front of all Israel in their hearing. ¹² "Assemble the people, the men and the women and children and the alien who is in your town, so that they may hear and learn and fear the LORD your God, and be careful to observe all the words of this law. ¹³ "Their children, who have not known, will hear and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as you live on the land which you are about to cross the Jordan to possess." Deuteronomy 31:7-13

¹⁴ "Now behold, today I am going the way of all the earth, and you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one word of all the good words which the LORD your God spoke concerning you has failed; all have been fulfilled for you, not one of them has failed. ¹⁵ "It shall come about that just as all the good words which the LORD your God spoke to you have come upon you, so the LORD will bring upon you all the threats, until He has destroyed you from off this good land which the LORD your God has given you. Joshua 23:14-15

Our God is Forgiving

²⁰ "He shall also do with the bull just as he did with the bull of the sin offering; thus he shall do with it. So the priest shall make atonement for them, and they will be forgiven. Leviticus 4:20

²⁶ "All its fat he shall offer up in smoke on the altar as in the case of the fat of the sacrifice of peace offerings. Thus the priest shall make atonement for him in regard to his sin, and he will be forgiven. Leviticus 4:26

¹⁰ "The second he shall then prepare as a burnt offering according to the ordinance. So the priest shall make atonement on his behalf for his sin, which he has committed, and it will be forgiven him. Leviticus 5:10

⁷ and the priest shall make atonement for him before the LORD, and he will be forgiven for any one of the things which he may have done to incur guilt." Leviticus 6:7

¹ How blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven,
Whose sin is covered!

² How blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity,
And in whose spirit there is no deceit!...

⁵ I acknowledged my sin to You,
And my iniquity I did not hide;
I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD";
And You forgave the guilt of my sin. Psalm 32:1-2, 5

¹ Be gracious to me, O God, according to Your loving kindness;
According to the greatness of Your compassion blot out my transgressions.

² Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity

⁷ Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean;

¹⁴ "However, in the future I will allure her;

when she came up from the land of Egypt.
